



Information For Police Officers

As a registered user you have free access to search the only database of household goods, which may be privately owned or owned by a rental/leasing company. Searches can be conducted through a website or mobile apps. You can send an emailed alert to the owner of an item, such as a TV.

Alerts are sent by a simple push button, and the recipient is forwarded your nominated contact details. You will be provided a transaction number which the goods owner will also receive by email. You may choose to use this to verify the identity of the owner of an item.

The database can be searched in Police activities, and where suspicion is raised, say as to the ownership of a phone, a Police Officer in the field, can send an alert to the owner of an item, then if the holder of the phone is unable to confirm a transaction number of a registered item, it could be reasonably presumed that the item has been stolen.

A genuine Police email address is required to access the database.

Only the phone number (eg Station Number) you wish to provide and your chosen name will be provided on email alerts.

Your privacy is valued and information that is collected will not be on sold, given away or otherwise divulged except by a court order.
